KING'S CORONATION raced in hand outside early, advanced nearing the stretch, dug in gamely between rivals and prevailed under a drive. SAN TELMO raced close up early, rallied nearing the stretch and dug in gamely along the inside in the drive. PEACE EMBLEM raced between rivals early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. CONQUER THE DEVIL was outrun early, was steadied entering the turn, raced wide and finished well. LIPAN was outrun early, raced wide and posed no real threat. CLEVER GREEK raced inside and had no response when roused. VEST set the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. EAST OF SUEZ chased the pace along the inside and tired. LOOKING BEST was steadied into the turn and tired.
