MARGARITA RITA quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, dug in gamely in the stretch and just missed. MAGIC MOMENTUM was outrun early, raced three wide and offered a mild rally outside. EXPIRATION DAY chased the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. PEAK MARIA'S WAY raced four wide and tired. S. S. BELLE tired after a half mile. MY SPECIAL GIRL stumbled at the start and tired.
