Footnotes

CODE OF CONDUCT bided time near the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up the pace in preparation for the stretch drive, swung four wide into the lane, took off in earnest when called upon, went by the front runners to take over leaving the furlong grounds and edged away under good handling. MOSQUITO was placed to a snug hold soon after leaving the starting gate, remained under it until about the half mile pole, with rider increasing his grip on the reins at several junctions to throttle down his mount's apparent early eagerness, responded well when given some rein at the half mile pole, raced between rivals for a while before angling four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, was set down after spinning into the lane, fought his way to the front with an eighth to go, was powerless to stave off the top one, but dug in with good determination to preserve the place. MAGNIFICENT MOON took the inside route, slipped off the rail late on the far turn and displayed a good kick down the center of the course to take the show. STEEL BRIDGE patiently tracked the front runner while taking the inside route, found room to ease into the two path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, made a run to loom momentarily by the eighth pole, but soon flattened out. DYNAFORTWO prompted the pacesetter from the the outside, made a successful bid between rivals for command in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home still holding a slim advantage, but with others in hot pursuit, offered good resistance during the ensuing furlong, got displaced at the eighth pole and steadily weakened thereafter. WIN THE DAY three wide around both turns, made no serious bids. FIRE WITH FIRE underwent a three to four wide journey and had no rally. COUSIN RICH assumed a forward position soon after the start, attended the pacesetter three wide around the far turn until upper stretch and folded. VOLITION rated inside until the five-sixteenths pole, wilted.
