SIRTORI bobbled at the break, tracked the speedy pace maker the closest in pursuit from the two path, came under urging to narrow the gap at the five-sixteenths, ranged up to confront the leader at the quarter pole, battled on brushing with that foe nearing the furlong marker, continued on determined under a snug right handed hold while under a left handed drive to keep a straight course and edge away a few strides from the wire. WHY ARGUE midpack in pursuit of the front while saving ground, swung three wide at the quarter under a drive, steadily closed on the front with good energy to just procure the place honors in the last jump. SHERIDAN SQUARE broke sharply, crossed to the inside while speeding off to the front, set solid fractions, was confronted at the head of the lane, put to a drive, dug in, brushed with the winner nearing the eighth pole, battled on stubbornly, yielded grudgingly in the last few strides while settling for show honors in a good effort. PURE NATURE chased the pace saving ground along the inside throughout, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. UTOPIAN DREAM chased the pace three to four wide while prominent for a half and faded. KEYALY chased from afar while saving ground, passed tired foes in the lane. PURPLE PICO chased the front four wide throughout offering no response when called upon nearing the quarter pole. SNAP CALL off a beat slow at the start conceding about three lengths, was put to the whip and asked from the get go to get involved, commenced a long

drive from the half mile pole and tired. INQUEST stumbled badly just after the start, raced wide throughout and was eased at the head of the lane.
