BELIEF SYSTEM underwent a ground-saving journey, was put to a drive well before reaching the end of the backstretch, overhauled the top twosome during the process of cutting the corner into the lane, drew out to his biggest advantage by the eighth pole, then dug in well enough long enough to fend off the resolute runner up. CHAPMAN chased IN HARM'S WAY nearly from the get-go, was three wide while undergoing the task, got set down a short distance from the end of the bend and latched on for the initial time, with the top one all the while taking over the lead and edging away, continued on with good determination but had to settle for being second best. IN HARM'S WAY was rated in the two path on a loosely-contested lead to the quarter pole, gave way after entering the stretch. LAILA'S JAZZ hustled by the pilot leaving the starting gate, arrived at the half mile pole as the trailer nonetheless, was guided over to the rail at that station and rode it for the rest of the way, was put to a drive after going halfway around the turn, faltered. PETROCELLI two wide on the turn, tired.
