Footnotes

YO BLUE away with no apparent mishap, had the pilot with a firm grip on the reins while establishing control in the opening stages, was sent over to the inside route, had the primary pursuer, that being EXCESS LIQUIDITY, increase his presence slightly midway down the backstretch, continued to show being rated along until coming to the quarter pole, turned for home and was let out, dug in well during the late stages to stave off the second place finisher. CHARDSEY well reserved on the first turn as well down the backstretch, began to pick up the pace upon entering the second bend, advanced into contention with a rail run, cut the corner into the stretch with good momentum, cleared all front runners but for one, the winner, and altered course to the outside with about an eighth to go, closed in well belatedly but fell considerably short at the wire. EXCESS LIQUIDITY stalked the winner from the outside and held on well to the end for the show. IMPETUOUS SPIRIT (GB) was unhurried towards the two path until past the midway point on the far turn, was taken hold as the runner up was cutting the corner into the lane, with a brief loss of ground as a result, ducked inward in upper stretch and launched a rail rally that had him loom momentarily as a serious threat, flattened out. NELSON AVENUE rated in the pocket for slightly over three-quarters, got eased

outward prior to spinning into the lane, came up empty. PRIMARY FOCUS raced from off the off the inside, was three wide and under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole undergoing an abbreviated move to reach prominence, made no additional headway once settled into upper stretch and backed away. LIGHT OF MERCY three wide around both turns, folded. EPIC LEGEND clipped POWER OF THE HEART's heels on the first turn and was outrun thereafter. POWER OF THE HEART got clipped from behind travelling on the opening bend, underwent a ground-saving journey and trailed. SCOFIELD broke slowly, propped after appearing to take a bad step, stopped on a dime, was pulled up and walked off the course. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
