DAYATTTHESPA attended the pace maker two to three wide early on, ranged up under her own power when given a notch to take narrow command three furlongs out, raced between rivals through the latter portion of the turn coming under urging at the five-sixteenths, cleared the inside pace presence to cut the corner into the lane confronted by KIBOSH on nearly even terms to the outside at the quarter pole, kicked clear repulsing that foe through the stretch to prevail. KIBOSH three wide within range of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun two to three wide into the stretch on nearly even terms with the aforementioned rival, couldn't match strides with that one effectively getting repulsed straightened away, offered up good energy for the place clear of the rest. ELUSIVE RUMOUR three to four wide in pursuit within aim under light coaxing, came under a drive three furlongs out, offered up mild energy through the lane for the show honors while never threatening the top two in the drive. MY JOPIA broke out a step at the start and was corrected, settled on the pace from just off the inside initially in hand, shifted to the fence at the half mile pole, had the eventual winner poke a head in front three furlongs out, remained patiently handled through the latter part of the turn, got set down cutting the corner into the stretch now in behind a pair and weakened in the stretch. MYSTIC CITY two to three wide towards the rear, saved ground through the far turn ridden along from midway and trailed.
