Footnotes

INDIAN LILLY away well, moved up to vie for the lead along the inside, was joined by BUTTONFRONT early on the turn, to make it a three way scramble, proved best of that threesome to edge away coming to the furlong marker, lengthened away to her biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, then held sway, driving. BLONDECAT stumbled after appearing to take an awkward start just of the starting gate, lost her best stride and dropped way to the back of the pack, got going again soon afterwards, but with much to do, cut into the gap while taking the inside route during the run around the bend, sped onwards towards the front runners after cutting the corner into the lane, picked up momentum nearing the eighth pole, altered course, splitting opponents in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and got up for the place with a belatedly burst of energy. FIDDLERS DIVA came in at the start, making contact with MY DONNA JEAN, was unhurried along the outside for nearly a half, responded positively once given her cue, finishing willingly to earn the show. KITTY'S THUNDER saved ground, was taken off the inside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward for the stretch run, beating MY DONNA JEAN for the three path at the head of the stretch, and making the loser of that path steady, advanced but a short distance when taken off heels at the three-sixteenths pole, altering course for optimal racing clearance, resumed her bid, but soon flattened out. FAMOUS ROSE was bumped at the start, vied between rivals on the turn and weakened during the final furlong. BUTTONFRONT left the backstretch three wide, ranged up to contest the pace, the outermost member of a three ply battle, was shaken off by the top one, drifted a bit into the stretch and tired. MY DONNA JEAN bumped between rivals, was squeezed back at the start, went on to take up position in midpack, was coaxed along to keep pace within striking distance behind an ongoing pace dispute on the turn, attempted to swing three wide into upper stretch, but was steadied when beaten to that lane by KITTY'S THUNDER, had little impact on the race thereafter.
