Footnotes

HUNGRY ISLAND contently rode the hedge throughout the opening half, lost some ground during the run around the second bend, lacking clearance to advance along the inside and the needed room to angle outward, was given some rein departing the five-sixteenths pole when FAR ISLE vacated the inside, gained readily cutting the corner into the lane, altered course outward to the middle of the course in two stages, kicked in after completing the maneuver, rapidly cut into the leader's margin, charged by in the final seventy yards and edged clear. WET ONE (IRE) raced three wide around both turns, responded positively when given her cue in upper stretch, finishing with good energy to procure the place. EVER ADORED took up the role of stalker soon after the start, was put to a good hold patiently keeping an eye from the outside on the pacesetter, moved when ready nearing the end of the run around the second bend, bumped with FAR ISLE, herself jammed up amongst rivals at this crucial juncture, in the middle of her move, got going again in short order, fought her way to a slim advantage, dug in with good determination before relinquishing in deep stretch but held on gamely for the show. LAKE SUMNER sauntered to the front after leaving the starting gate and settled along the hedge, set the fractions, well rated and mildly pressed, continued along the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, was let out in upper stretch as several rivals began to bear down, held her ground for an additional furlong and steadily weakened thereafter. AN ABSOLUTE TEN stalked the pacesetter from the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. L'ETOILE BLEUE (GER) was placed under a snug hold a short distance from the start and dragged towards the back of the pack, was taken outward after entering the backstretch, appeared uncomfortable between rivals still well held, approaching the half mile pole, chose the overland route for run around the far turn, displayed a good of speed, still under her own power, early on the second turn, spun wide into the lane and soon flattened out. FAR ISLE placed under a snug early hold, was taken back into the pocket, sat there under a good hold for six furlongs, squeezed her way into the two path, soon after leaving the five-sixteenths pole, found herself jammed up behind traffic as the field approached the quarter pole, bumped with EVER ADORED turning for home, failed to pick up interest thereafter. FASHION FORWARD strung out three wide around the opening bend, ventured to the overland route for the subsequent one and had no rally. ARCH ROYAL trailed.
