BRUCE ALLEY chased from afar, advanced steadily towards the leader under encouragement around the far turn, sustained the momentum turning for home, gained rapidly, wrested away the lead with a sixteenth remaining and edged clear. HYPER was bumped lightly bumped at the break, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to take the place. PEGASUS TOMMY D. sped off under his own to a commanding lead down the backstretch, showed the way from the two path, was asked for a response as the field began to close in, took these as far as the sixteenth pole in front, got overhauled and weakened into the third slot. FRESHMAN DORM outrun for six furlongs, had a good finish down the center of the course to garner the final major slice of the pot. CON THE CAT bumped lightly with HYPER at the start, was the closer pursuer for nearly three-quarters and had no kick. LEATHERHEAD lacked the needed response. INK three wide departing the backstretch, was put to a prolonged drive but failed to gain ground appreciably. KID CURRY was through after completing six furlongs.
