**Footnotes**

NAMRON patiently stalked the pacesetter three wide, issued a challenge approaching the quarter pole, sparred with the runner up on nearly even terms until past the eighth pole, shook free and edged away under good handling. LOGICAL ORDER broke sharply, quickly cleared the competition in hand and was tucked over to the inside, showed the way from there, came under heavy pressure late on the far turn and was let out in response, battled intensely with the winner down the stretch, yielded reluctantly leaving the furlong grounds, but continued on with good determination to garner the place. THE LAURELS

swung four wide into the stretch and displayed a good kick down the center of the course to grab show honors. CAT SWEEP strung out in the four path on the turn, held on well to end. MIGHTYLOVER raced from between rivals near the two path on the turn, had the rider atop with a firm grip on the reins, getting shuffled back during the later stages of the run around the bend, had sufficient clearance entering the stretch and responded positively once given his cue, regained the lost ground and then some from upper to midstretch, but could not sustain the run during the last eighth. MAN IN BROWN SUIT was hustled from the starting gate to secure a forward post, settled into the pocket early down the backstretch, tracked the pacesetter from there, rated until the five-sixteenths pole, fell back steadily thereafter. STORIESINTHEDARK raced from off the rail and lacked the necessary stretch response. FAST GRIEVANCE three wide around the turn, was much wider at the head of the stretch, failed to come up with a solid closing punch. WON O WON raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. PATENT PENDING TOM saved ground to no avail. L. C. SLEEPY accompanied the pacesetter from the two path for nearly three-quarters before backing away. FLATOUT ROYAL took the inside route and faded.
