Footnotes

POWER WORLD broke well from the starting gate, took up the chase from the two path, fell back slightly between calls but picked up interest on the turn and made up the lost ground before completing the opening half, turned for home and went after the leader in earnest, was the first of the two front runners to arrive at the eighth pole, kicked away the final furlong, hand urged while being intermittently flashed the whip from the right side. OBVIOUSLY TUESDAY out broke the field and quickly established control, was rated in the two path on an open lead, continued along on the same scenario until upper stretch, sensed the presence of the top one at this stage and was let just past the three-sixteenths pole, relinquished nonetheless before going an additional sixteenth, continued on willingly for place honors. HOW DO I WIN raced three wide on the turn and proved no match for the top pair. CONGO rode the rail until the quarter pole, had no response. WON FAST BULLET raced along the outside and was no factor. DANGEROUS LAD four wide departing the backstretch, folded. BROOKLYN RED darted to the inside, remained there for just over a half, swung into the three path once settled in upper stretch, came up empty.
