Footnotes

CRESCENT SHORE sparred with SUBTLE from the two path, took off and shook free of that opponent during the run through the furlong grounds, held sway, driving. SO FASHION gave chase from the two path, under urging for much of the going on the turn, altered course outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, taking BONITA SONATA along for a brief ride, flashed some belatedly energy to secure second. BONITA SONATA off the inside, swung from the three path into the stretch, was carried out slightly while the runner up was maneuvering outward in upper stretch, then rallied for the show. TYPHOON TERI underwent a three wide pursuit, weakened. SUBTLE quickly in front, was joined by the top one before reaching the half mile pole, raced as a team with that rival until upper stretch before backing away. QUIET ENDING raced along the outside, was coaxed chasing the pace combatants for the opening half, folded. MARCY set down at the three-eighths pole, faltered. DEPUTY JAZZ out hustled at the start, trailed throughout.
