SNORTER pressed the pace from the outside, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. BLACK MAMBO was outrun early, rallied on the turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely to be easily best of the others. FIVE EIGHTY FOUR was hustled along inside, chased the pace and tired in the stretch. LITERARY ROW set the pace along the inside and tired after the opening three quarters. CARRIER chased the pace while three wide and tired. QUARTER POUNDER had no response when roused. SHOO BRUSH stumbled badly at the start, unseating his rider. Following a general Stewards' inquiry the result was declared official.
