Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 other than restricted since October 1 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 other than restricted, 4 lbs.; \$30,000, or two races other than maiden, claiming or restricted, 6 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. Trophy to the winning owner presented by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closes Saturday, April 23, 2005 with 16 Nominations.

SEEKING THE ANTE was outrun early, raced three wide, responded when roused, dug in gamely outside and was along late under a drive. SLEW MOTION raced close up outside while in hand, rallied three wide on the turn, led into deep stretch and was caught in the final yards. EXIT TO HEAVEN was hustled to the front, set the pace while in hand and weakened along the inside in the final furlong. ACEY DEUCEY was outrun early, raced inside and offered a mild rally along the inside. WINNING SEASON chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. QUITE A RUCKUS raced close up while between rivals and tired after a half mile. BRIGHT MAHOGANY showed speed along the inside and was finished early.
