Footnotes

NEXT DAY trailed after a slow start, raced far back along the inside, saved ground to the top of the stretch, angled out leaving the quarter pole then closed steadily under right hand urging to get up in the final strides. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK was reserved after breaking slowly, moved up four wide on the backstretch, closed the gap from outside to threaten at the quarter pole, gained a slim lead inside the furlong marker, led into deep stretch and yielded late. NOLITE TIMERE bobbled after being bumped at the start, raced in good position along the inside to the turn and rallied belatedly. COALTOWN LEGEND was rated just off the pace between rivals, angled in on the turn, lacked the needed response when blocked in traffic in upper stretch and rallied mildly when clear. ODESSA'S HOPE raced uncontested on the rail to the turn and weakened. MEL'S GOLD pressed the pace between horses, lodged a brief bid at the quarter pole and flattened out. MARSCAPONI was outrun while racing wide throughout.
