STATION HILL settled in good position along the rail, swung out entering the stretch then wore down the runner-up to win going away. REMARK pressed the pace from outside, opened a clear advantage in midstretch but couldn't hold off the winner in the final eighth. FASHION INSIDER was outrun early after a slow start, saved ground to the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. AFLEETING LADY raced in midpack and lacked a late response then pulled up in distress after the wire and was vanned off. SUPER ESPRESSO chased wide along the backstretch, drifted five wide leaving the turn and lacked a late response. ALLA PRIMA set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and faltered. LADY BALLA VALE never reached contention while saving ground. CONSPICUOUS raced up close between horses, drifted wide at the quarter pole and faded. PERSISTENCE checked at the start and was never close thereafter.
