DAVERON (GER) bumped with AINMAA just out of the starting gate, was put to a snug hold and settled within range of the pacesetter in the two path, stalked the leader down the backstretch, rating kindly, maneuvered into the three path entering the second turn, continued to bide time until leaving the five-sixteenths pole, advanced with good energy when given some rein at that station, to loom boldly, the widest of the three front runners turning for home on nearly even terms, charged to the front when asked for a response soon after settling into upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds the clear leader, but with GITCHEE GOOMIE in close proximity and bearing down hard, dug in with good determination and successfully fended off the previously mentioned rival to prove best. GITCHEE GOOMIE sat reserved along the inside before guided into the two path approaching the half mile pole, continued along, unhurried during the run around the far turn, angled three wide for the stretch, loosely drafting behind the winner, tipped outward one additional path for optimal racing clearance and took off in earnest, closed with good energy leaving the eighth pole, but was denied and had to settle for being second best. BET ON THE BLUE was bumped at the start, rode the hedge, improved position down the backstretch, still under a good hold, briefly waited behind rivals approaching the quarter pole, angled three wide in upper stretch, got called upon, but lacked the necessary stretch response. AINMAAA was bumped by BET ON THE BLUE at the break, bounced off that opponent into the winner a stride later, was put to a firm hold, but dragged the rider forward into the role of stalker nonetheless, was rated prompted the leader, drew abreast of the leader in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, sat poised until the head of the stretch, was let loose but proved empty. COMIC MARVEL well rated along the inside cutting the fractions, was readily displaced at the quarter pole despite being asked for a response and steadily tired thereafter.
