AULD ALLIANCE (IRE) broke on top, was placed to a firm hold and allowed to ease back, kept watch on the pacesetter, firmly rated, was forced to remain on hold heading to the quarter pole, entered the stretch, found enough room to maneuver and did so, gradually getting placed in the three path by the end of the furlong grounds, kicked into her best stride with about a sixteenth to go, finished full of run to shoot past an embattled pair in the last seventy yards and get up at the wire. PRECARIOUS swung three wide into the backstretch, remained parked out in the same path for the start of the run around second bend, picked up interest when asked to and ranged up towards the leader into the teeth of the fastest split of the event, latched on fully to GLORIOUS CHANT heading home, forged her way to a slim advantage during the ensuing furlong, clung desperately to it, still locked in battle with the previously-mentioned foe, got nipped at the finish line. GLORIOUS CHANT had control and a place along the rail by the end of the homestretch, cut the pace, well rated and loosely pressed in the early going, picked up the pace noticeably after the half had been completed, yet came under intensified pressure nevertheless, got set down for the drive home, yielded reluctantly, held on with good determination, but had to settle for the show. SATISFACTION off the inside and unhurried during the opening stages, launched a run four wide from the five-sixteenths marker, flattened out about a furlong later. ADRIATIC DREAM came out slightly, making light contact with LONG BLOOMING ROSE, raced along the outside, commenced the stretch four to five wide, lacked the needed response. LONG BLOOMING ROSE shied outward in reacting to ADRIATIC DREAM as the field was sent on its way, chased the pacesetter from between rivals on the far turn, gave way.
