FREE OF LOVE raced close up early, was hustled up three wide entering the turn, advanced outside nearing the stretch, dug in gamely when roused and drew clear late under a drive. DAYTON FLYER was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside and dug in gamely through the stretch. COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, circled widest into the stretch and finished well outside. SEEKING DAYLIGHT was hustled along early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and lacked a solid closing kick. WINDSOR CASTLE was rated along outside, altered course to the inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a strong finish. GRIFFINITE was urged along outside, put in a five wide run on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch drive. OPEN SESAME was hard-ridden while four wide but had no response and tired in the stretch. COMIC GENIUS was bumped at the start, chased the pace along the inside and was finished early. KING'S MESSENGER was sent to the front, set the pace under constant pressure and tired in the stretch.
