Footnotes

TO TELL THE TRUTH pressed the pace in hand along the backstretch, cruised to the front from outside on the turn, shook loose when threatened leaving the quarter pole and drew off under steady left hand urging. COLONIAL KID was rated in midpack, lodged a steady move between horses to challenge nearing the quarter pole but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. PRINCE DUBAI was well placed along the inside for five furlongs, swung four wide while gaining at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. PERFECT PRECISION was unhurried for a half, raced between horses on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. HI DADDY chased outside for five furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. PATENT PENDING TOM broke in the air at the start coming out well behind the field and was never close thereafter. BARTLETTS gave way on the turn after setting the early pace and was eased late. BRUSHED PRINCE never reached contention.
