COCALERO was outrun early after breaking slowly, raced behind a wall of horses on the turn, bumped with LLOYDOBLER while splitting horses to get clear at the quarter pole then finished well in the middle of the track to edge away in the late stages. ENCLOSURE was reserved between horses, split horses entering the stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. GRAYSONIA settled inside, got through along the rail to gain a clear advantage in midstretch and weakened late. KELLS BLUES chased three wide, gained in upper stretch and flattened out. LLOYDOBLER pressed the pace from outside, drifted out at the quarter pole and tired. GOLD IS GOOD dueled for five furlongs and gave way. STRATFORD HILL raced wide on the turn and lacked a late response.
