STAKES Dwyer S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 may be made at time of entry. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. All starters to receive a \$1,500 rebate. All supplemental nominations will be required to pay the entry fee. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. NYRA will waive the entry and starting fees for the Belmont Stakes to any of the first three finishers from the Dwyer who are original Triple Crown nominees and who compete in the Belmont Stakes. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 other than restricted stake at a mile or over, or three races, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 24, 2010 with 40 Nominations.

FLY DOWN dropped back in hand after breaking alertly, was unhurried while trailing for a half mile, launched an outside bid leaving the far turn, made a strong four wide move to reach contention midway on the turn, took the lead in upper stretch, shook loose opening a comfortable advantage in midstretch then drew away under steady right hand encouragement. DROSSELMEYER trailed briefly after breaking slowly, moved up gradually in hand along the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn, raced behind a wall of horses while reaching striking distance midway on the turn, swung four wide for clear sailing at the quarter pole, took up chase after the winner in upper stretch but was no match for that one while finishing willingly to best the others. REMAND was unhurried for a half, raced in the middle of the pack for six furlongs, circled five wide while launching his bid to reach contention on the turn, made a brief move to threat at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing response. SOARING EMPIRE pressed the pace in the three path along the backstretch, edged closer midway on the turn, surged to the front gaining a brief lead at the quarter pole, relinquished command to the winner in upper stretch and gradually tired thereafter. CARNIVORE moved up along the inside, took the lead in hand before going a half, set the pace inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. TURF MELODY set or forced the pace inside to the far turn and gave way. CODOY raced well back between horses on the backstretch and gave way at the three-eighths pole.
