LADY ON THE RUN sluggish leaving the starting gate, found her stride after being placed to mild hand urging, began a long match from the three path at the half mile pole, advanced willingly under strong encouragement, altered course slightly inward coming to the head of the stretch, continued to close in readily, altered course back outside near the eighth pole, once SALTAMONTES began to drift out, powered by a now weakening GOOD HABITS to take over a short way into the last eighth and drew clear, being kept busy to the end. FREUDS ON HOLIDAYS chased the pace combatants from the outside, was asked for a response on the turn to keep pace, and although no match for the top one, came home willingly enough to be well clear of the others for place honors. GOOD HABITS was pulled off SOUNDS FREUDIAN after making light contact with that opponent just out of the starting gate, quickly reached the front and was soon joined by SALTAMONTES, argued the pace from the two path with that rival before putting her away after going a half, was starting to weaken when the winner made her presence felt midstretch, surrendered the lead readily but held well enough to salvage the show. SALTAMONTES sparred with GOOD HABITS while travelling in the three path, backed away after going a half, then drifted out while tiring in the lane. SOUNDS FREUDIAN bumped lightly with GOOD HABITS at the start, settled along the inside soon afterwards and was never a factor. SILKY ME was no menace. KOCHER GIRL three wide at the half mile pole, failed to reach a contending position.
