SOUNDS FAMILIAR bumped at the start, settled into midpack down the backstretch, maintained position, surrounded on all sides by rivals, under some coaxing, was put to a firmer grip on reins, still mired amongst foes, awaiting options from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, spotted daylight and made a four wide run towards it, turning for home, commenced to rally in earnest once straightened away, drifted outward under her volition after a steady diet of left handed stick work in upper stretch, forged on ahead, getting the nose down in time on the wire to come out on top in the win photo. MYRTLE'S GRAY showed the way from the inside for a half, was roused entering the stretch, saw her lead dwindle down steadily leaving the furlong grounds, drifted outward in the late stages after being on the receiving end of left handed encouragement and missed. ZELLWEGER tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, found room to slip out of it approaching the quarter pole, gained readily on the leader during the run through the furlong grounds, likewise drifted outward, in similar fashion to the first two finishers, from left handed whipping, from about midstretch, finished with good determination, but had to settle for the show. BOBITY BOO three wide for most of the way around the turn, took off in earnest from the five path at the top of the lane and came home willingly. READYGETSGOLD within striking distance until midstretch, lacked the needed response. CAP THE THUNDER saved ground, made a bid but flattened out during the last eighth. ALL QUIET raced along the outside and was no factor. VOYAGER bumped at the start, prompted three wide and gave way. LADY'S LUNAR LUCK bumped between rivals at the start, was forwardly placed in the three path for a half and faded. KISSES FROM KAREN bobbed, prior to taking a bad step down the backstretch, was successfully eased out of the harm's way, pulled up and subsequently vanned off. There was a Stewards'

Inquiry focusing on the incident down the backstretch before the result was declared official.
