CABARET COWBOY set a pressured pace along the rail for a half, shook off the runner-up to get clear in upper stretch, extended his lead when roused in midstretch and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. RICORIATOA pressed the winner from outside into upper stretch but couldn't stay with that one while holding well to narrowly gain the place. WINGED HERO was well placed along the rail to the turn, swung out entering the stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. BIMINI trailed after breaking slowly, closed a lengthy gap along the rail nearing the quarter pole but couldn't sustain his bid. MOLTEN LAVA checked in traffic at the half mile pole and failed to mount a serious rally thereafter. PAX checked in tight at the start, raced within striking distance between horses for a half and lacked a late response. STEEL BLUE saved ground to no avail. SPANISH HARLAN never reached contention while seven wide entering the stretch. ABU RACER chased three wide then drifted five wide while giving way at the quarter pole.
