STAKES Peter Pan S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. Starters to receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. NYRA will waive the entry and starting fees for the Belmont Stakes to any of the first three finishers from the Peter Pan who are Triple Crown eligible only and who compete in the Belmont Stakes (total value \$20,000). 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 other than restricted stake at a mile or over, or three races, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 25, 2009 with 31 Nominations.

**Footnotes**

CHARITABLE MAN was well placed in hand, angled inside the pacesetter midway down the backstretch, closed the gap in hand midway on the turn, eased out while rallying at the quarter pole, charged to the front in upper stretch then edged away under strong right hand encouragement. IMPERIAL COUNCIL raced in good position while unhurried along the backstretch, made a steady run along the rail to reach contention on the turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole, lodged a bid outside the winner in upper stretch but was no match for that one while holding well for the place. BRAVE VICTORY raced far back for six furlongs, worked his way forward along the rail nearing the quarter pole, drifted out after the rider lost the whip inside the three-sixteenths pole then closed steadily from outside to gain a share. HELLO BROADWAY moved up in hand, raced well off the rail while opening a long lead on the backstretch, angled in while well in front midway on the turn, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and tired from his early efforts. SCOREWITHCATER raced well back for a half, gained slightly from outside on the turn, swung five wide entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. AL KHALI raced in good position in the three path for six furlongs, dropped back at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. STATELY CHARACTER broke a bit slowly then trailed throughout.
