GOLDEN GULCH departed the backstretch from the four path, moved up latched on to the runner up coming to the three-eighths pole to shoot past the early pacesetter, turned for home and was asked for his best, forged his way to the front by midstretch then edged away, kept to a drive. BLACK N BEAUTY prompted the leader, taking up the role of stalker early down the backstretch, was coaxed along to maintain interest, issued a successful challenge for command at the midway point on the turn, spun into the lane with the top one in hot pursuit, fell back a sliver after a hard fought battle during the run through the furlong grounds, then dug in well enough long enough to salvage second. SELF CONTROL unhurried for over a half, picked up interest nearing the three-eighths pole, ducked inward late on the turn and cut the corner under encouragement, finished well, but missed out on place honors. CHARLES RUSSELL showed the way from the two path, put up little resistance when confronted by each of the first two finishers in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole and gave way. DREAMING BLUE off a beat slowly, was urged down the chute to secure a forward position, faded off the subsequent-ground saving journey.
