Footnotes

ADIRONDACK EXPRESS raced towards the inside down the backstretch, slipped into the two path a short distance past the half mile pole, was put to stronger and stronger urging the farther along he travelled on the turn, felt the right whip prior to and while spinning three wide into upper stretch, maintained the momentum once straightened away and took over the lead with a furlong to go, edged away. BUDGE MAN the early trailer, was put five wide at the head of the stretch, mustered up a solid stretch response to secure the place. JEMARU underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, ranged up coming to the quarter pole and challenged for command as the field headed into the lane, gained a slim advantage only to have it snatched away by the top one before making it safely through the furlong grounds, held on well in the late stages to preserve show honors. CONVOCATION out broke the competition by a length as the field was sent on its way, was under the mildest of coaxing getting displaced on the front by QUIET FAVORITE, tucked into the pocket in time for the run around the bend, stayed in contention, once more under some light coaxing, entered the stretch and came up empty. STAR OF NEW YORK failed to menace. QUIET FAVORITE took over the advantage shortly after the start, sat entrenched in the two path showing the way while getting rated by the rider, felt the pressure intensify late on the bend and turned for home on near even terms with JEMARU, quickly succumbed and tired. MARQUET REBEL lunged at the break, chased four wide on the turn and gave way.
