Footnotes

HAY SHARES took command soon after the start, cut the pace, being rated along from a slight distance off the rail, approached the head of the stretch and was called upon, drifted out several paths in the final furlong but held on safely. ANAPHYLAXIS well reserved from off the inside, departed the backstretch the widest off all, marched into contention with a bold run while taking the overland route, turned for home closer to the rail and challenged in earnest outside the other two front runners, made up minimal ground during the initial portion of the stretch drive, had more success afterwards, continued onward with good courage to the end but fell short. BIGGER IS BETTOR did most of his tracking while sitting in the pocket, was put to encouragement while vacating the premises leaving the five-sixteenths pole, had the runner up arrive on the scene and thus bid for control between rivals heading for the top of the lane, remained well in contention before weakening in the final stages. PAPA TOM outrun for slightly over a half, raced from off the inside on the turn, got put to encouragement late on the bend and swung four wide into the stretch, drifted inward a couple of paths from upper to midstretch, made no impact. MIGHTY ONE four wide at the three-eighths pole, folded. WON GREAT CLASSIC squeezed into the two path at the top of the turn, kept pace with the front runners for a while longer and gave way. SWAG DADDY two to three wide, was between rivals for a good portion of the way around the turn, appeared done by the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back quickly and was taken hold on, then was eventually eased.
