Footnotes

DEFINE two to three wide, crept up into contention during the run around the bend, got placed into the five path during the initial stages of the drive home, worked his way to the front with about a sixteenth to go, edged away, hand urged crossing the wire. MAKE A FORTUNE sparred with SILVER MORGAN while taking the three path, spun into the stretch, arrived at the eighth pole clutching a slim advantage, but with the winner lurking a threat a short distance behind, yielded shortly afterwards, held on well though for the place. SILVER MORGAN raced from off the inside throughout, was pulling on the bit early down the backstretch, vied to maintain the lead, hand urged and taking the two path racing around the turn, drifted one path wider heading home, relinquished before going an additional eighth, weakened into the show slot. STEPHEN A had the rider take hold on the left side after breaking a few steps to the outside, rode the rail and in doing so was the sole participant to spend significant time down along the fence, cut the corner put to the whip, gained some ground as the tempo softened and the front runners went wider, then backed away again. PATRIOTIC DUTY chased from the two path and was always outrun.
