ALCHEMIST was angled to the outside soon after the start, raced with the pace while three wide, responded when roused and drew clear late, driving. SKIP QUEEN was hustled to the front, set the pace while in hand and dug in gamely along the inside in the stretch. GLOWING COLORS raced close up along the inside early, put in a run on the rail nearing the stretch and tired in the drive. NORTHERN EXPOSURE raced greenly outside and tired. MONTEFIORE raced with the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. MERLOT MOMENT raced three wide and tired.
