CASINO DRIVE moved up rapidly after breaking slowly, settled in good position along the backstretch, gained on the turn, angled out at the quarter pole, took charge inside the three-sixteenths pole then drew off under steady right hand urging. MINT LANE rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace under pressure along the rail, set the pace to the top of the stretch, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and continued on willingly to narrowly hold the place. READY'S ECHO was far back after breaking slowly, saved ground to the turn, angled five wide entering the stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. GOLDEN SPIKES settled in good position between horses, advanced three wide to lodge a brief bid on the turn, and weakened under pressure through the stretch. COSMIC was outrun along the backstretch, raced well back for six furlongs, advanced four wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. SPARK CANDLE moved up rapidly, pressed the pace from outside for seven furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. TOMCITO checked in traffic along the backstretch, raced within striking distance to the turn and faded. DEPUTYVILLE raced between horses while four wide and lacked a rally. FAST TALKING raced wide throughout and tired.
