### Footnotes

TULIPMANIA checked after breaking slowly, closed the gap midway on the turn, waited behind a wall of horses nearing the quarter pole, split rivals while angling four wide entering the stretch then wore down the leaders under steady right hand urging. BANKER'S BUY raced well back for a half after being bumped at the start, circled five wide to reach contention nearing the quarter pole and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. HANNA CAN FLY settled in midpack, waited briefly while saving ground on the turn, charged through along the rail to take the lead in upper stretch and weakened late. DANCING DAISY checked after bumping BANKER'S BUY at the start, was unhurried for a half, swung four wide while gaining on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch and flattened out. KOUFAX CURVE pressed the pace between horses, gained a brief lead on the turn then gave way. HELLO GOLD raced in close contention between horses to the far turn and gave way. WISE CHOICE dueled along the rail for five furlongs and faltered.
