ANAAN settled just off the pace from outside for five furlongs, closed the gap four wide to reach contention entering the stretch, gained a slim lead in midstretch, fought heads apart into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. SPEIGHT OF HAND dueled along the rail into upper stretch, relinquished the lead in midstretch and battled back gamely along the inside to just miss. HERALD SQUARE saved ground just off the pace for six furlongs, was boxed in on the turn, altered course to the outside for room in midstretch and finished strongly but could not get up. LONG JUMP was outrun along the inside, swung five wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. BUDDY'S HOLIDAY pressed the pace in the two path to the turn, battled heads apart in midstretch and weakened. NO QUESTIONS was outrun to the turn, swung five wide entering the stretch and lacked a late response.
