RIGBY three wide in hand attending a pair on the front, took a narrow advantage under his own power straightened for home, got asked mildly for more at the three-sixteenths and edged clear through the stretch under a light drive. CHASING MOONLIGHT broke out at the start causing minor bumping between POPPA'S PICK and REGAL STRIKE, prompted the pace inside early under a snug near side hold into the turn, came under urging approaching the quarter pole still inside a pair, cut the corner into the lead at the head of the stretch, got headed soon after straightened away, proved no match for the top one while continuing the fight with POPPA'S PICK keeping on through the lane to procure the place. POPPA'S PICK on the pace from the two path between foes, got set down at the quarter pole, continued to battle on between rivals to the eighth pole when the eventual winner shook free, dug in offering up a mild kick tussling with CHASING MOONLIGHT to the wire to garner the show. SENSATIONAL SLAM hustled at the start, settled three to four wide within aim of the front, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths and offered no serious response. REGAL STRIKE bumped lightly between foes at the start due to pressure from CHASING MOONLIGHT breaking out a step, settled three wide just off the pace, got called upon at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the drive.
