Footnotes

MISS VALENTINE narrowed the gap from the front runners midway down the backstretch, contently stalked the front runners from the two path around the turn, entered the stretch and was asked for some run, followed CLEAR PASAJ outward during the initial portion of the stretch drive, cut the gap to latch on with about an eighth to go, took over the lead for good a short distance from the sixteenth pole and edged away. CLEAR PASAJ grabbed a forward position after the start, was rating from the outside while keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, ranged up and looked that foe in the eye by the midway point on the turn, raced as a team with that opponent for nearly the rest of the way to the quarter pole, took away the lead needing only her own power and with the other foe having the pilot asking his mount for some run, got set down for the stretch, drifted outward slightly in upper stretch, felt the winner's presence with a furlong remaining, yielded in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but held on long enough thereafter to salvage second. LADY ON THE RUN in a couple of steps leaving the starting gate, bobbled shortly afterwards, was along the rail proceeding towards the half mile pole, got tipped into the two path at the top of the turn, went a furlong down the road and was taken outward once more, entered the stretch and was called upon, displayed good belated energy en route for the show. ERIN ENCHANTED rode the rail from the nine-sixteenths marker to the quarter pole, angled outward for the start of the stretch run, got outfinished. GO UNBRIDLED three wide entering the turn, was about two paths wider exiting it, left the halfway point having already been placed to solid encouragement, made no impact. HARBOR MIST quickly established control, showed the way from the inside, had the runner draw abreast at the three-eighths pole, yielded despite being put to urging, tired after turning for home.
