SISTER CAT was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, dug in determinedly in the stretch and held on after a long drive. REYANA'S JET was outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and finished well outside. RAISIN' SILVER was bumped after the start, chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. LEAVEITINTHERING pressed the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. TAKE THE RATE was outrun early, angled out in the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. SPARKSFLY raced inside and tired. CLEAR HEELS had no rally. WHAT'S THAT MARNIE raced four wide and tired. BRAVO'S PRINCESS was bumped after the start, stumbled raced wide and tired.
