MR. RYDER placed under a good hold, bided time in the two path for three-quarters, spun into the stretch with clear sailing awaiting down along the inside, was put to energetic handling and drove forward, reached the sixteenth pole with the lead and inched away. GRAND CASH shot out of the starting gate en route to establishing control through a pokey opening quarter pole, continued to lay down soft splits, under a good hold and placed slightly off the inside, came under assault at the quarter pole, battled hard and gamely, having now been set down, got collared by the top one in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole but continued on with good determination to take the place. SLAMBINO saved ground taking the inside route during the initial stages, slipped into the two path soon after entering the far turn, came three to four wide for the stretch drive and displayed a good, but belatedly kick for the show. DAY OF DESTINY rated prompting the pacesetter from the outside, was given some rein coming to the seven-sixteenths pole, kept up the pressure, got set down in upper stretch and got out finished. HOPPSEY raced along the outside and had no rally. INDY SCENT three wide around both turns, made a quick bid coming to the quarter pole that soon fizzled out.
