DREAM DROP KID showed the way while racing along the inside, responded positively once called upon and edged away during the stretch drive. OUR ELI bobbed a few jumps out of the starting gate, took up chase mostly three wide around the turn, kept pace with the winner from the quarter pole to the furlong marker and held well thereafter to procure the place. JADED LOVER put to an early hold, sat reserved near the back of the pack for the initial half, began the run around the bend from between horses, hesitated for a stride or two, wedged in a bit tighter between opponents in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, found some daylight departing that station and angled four wide, under some encouragement into the lane, commenced to rally hand roused, was switched over to right handed stick work and lugged inward some in midstretch, drifted inward a second time a sixteenth down the road, sans whip, bothering a pair of rivals at this late stage, and continued on willingly to grab the show. SOUND OF DRUMS made an early dash to settle along the inside soon after the start, slipped outward on the turn in preparation for the stretch drive, briefly drafted JADED LOVER into the lane, lacked the necessary stretch response. SUAVE FOX gave chase from the outside and weakened during the last eighth. WINDAFULL the last to pop out of the starting gate, accelerated into midpack under his own power, displayed a touch of greenness, alternating between the rail and the two path, in two separate incidences approaching the half mile pole, finally gave in to the rider's directives and took up residence for good along the inside at this point, was making mild progress when forced to steady in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, in reaction to outside pressure originating from JADED LOVER, a short distance up ahead, got going again and flashed some interest. FORTY TEARS tracked the leader from the inside, appeared to be weakening, when taken in hand after being bothered by a rival near the sixteenth pole. HAYA'S BOY three to four wide around the turn, failed to reach contention. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE four wide midway on the turn, had no stretch offering to render. MAZARA DEL VALLO coaxed three wide down the backstretch, was given some rein and made a run at the leader on the turn, had nearly reached even terms before backing away, drifted six wide into the stretch while tiring badly. An objection lodged by the

rider of SOUND OF DRUMS against the rider of JADED LOVER alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
