ROARING TWENTIES, unhurried inside while her stablemate made the pace, found clear sailing on the rail on the turn, drew clear in the stretch and was kept to a drive to remain clear to the finish. EMANATING, outrun early, was bumped while between rivals on the turn, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. CONFORMAL raced with the pace while four wide and stayed on gamely to the finish. QUEEN'S WORD, hustled along outside, was taken to the inside entering the turn, was bumped midway on the turn, rallied wide and finished well. RAP AND DANCE was hustled from the gate, chased the pace for three quarters and tired in the stretch. CLEAR MARGINS raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. HONOUR A BULL raced between rivals and had no response when roused. ONE RUN BABY raced wide, was bumped on the turn and lacked a rally. COLD STARE was hustled along inside and tired. HOLY GOLIGHTLY set the pace while removed from the rail and tired.
