Non-winners of \$40,000 in 1999 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000; or \$30,000 since October 1, 5 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 9 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Restricted races not considered in allowances). Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, May 1, 1999 with 23 Nominations. OH WHAT A WINDFALL, hustled along outside, raced four wide, responded to steady pressure in the stretch and was along in final yards. PAVED IN GOLD contested the pace from between rivals while in hand, dug in when set down for the drive and battled gamely to the finish. THINGS CHANGE contested the pace along the inside while well in hand, dug in gamely in the stretch then altered course to the outside in deep stretch. CONFESSIONAL, close up inside while in hand, came four wide for the drive and finished gamely. SEEKING THE SKY was hustled along early, raced on the rail and finished with good courage. APPEALING PHYLLY was hustled from the gate, chased the pace while along the inside and lacked a rally. ELEKTRALINE contested the pace while three wide and tired in deep stretch. SUPERNAL was outrun.
