KATZ ME IF YOU CAN raced close up outside while in hand, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed after a long drive. LUCKY LIVI raced close up while three wide, angled in for the drive, angled out in midstretch, angled back in in deep stretch and finished gamely. SHINE AGAIN was rated along between rivals, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. SHUTUP AND DANCE contested the pace along the inside and continued on well through the stretch. FOLLY DOLLAR bobbled at the start, contested the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. IMADEED was rated from the start, was steadied along inside and was not a factor. CEDAR KNOLLS raced close up early, put in a four wide run on the turn and faded in the stretch. SWEPT AWAY was hustled along inside but had no response. DREAM FOR A MOMENT broke sluggishly, raced four wide and tired. AWAY raced three wide and tired.
