**Footnotes**

HARDSHELL was grabbed hold after stumbling at the start, yet still broke near the top, edged away to the lead and was angled over to the inside shortly afterwards, left the backstretch, from the inside, and with three rivals bearing down from his outside, inched clear of them all during the run around the bend, was let out after entering the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds holding his biggest advantage and safely maintained it, driving. TATAO'S WIDCAT left the backstretch from the four path, was the widest of a quartet vying for command, kept up as best as possible from the half mile pole to the quarter pole, responded well when asked for a response after straightening away in upper stretch and finished with good courage to earn the place. ENCHANTED STONE was bumped in the hind quarters by WEALTHY AVIATOR leaving the gate, got going quickly and was angled over into the three path nearing the half mile pole, remained unhurried for most of the way around the turn, got called upon in the lane and rallied willingly enough to secure the show. BRAVO ROMEO pressed between rivals until the quarter pole before backing away. VALID OCEAN PASS raced between rivals on the turn, made a mild run to reach contention, but flattened out during the last eighth. JOHNNY TWO BY FOUR three wide, contested the pace between rivals for a half and folded. WEALTHY AVIATOR bumped with ENCHANTED STONE after stumbling at the start, was steadied off heels in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole as the aforementioned rival maneuvered into the three path, entered the turn four wide, but was taken into the overland route by midpoint, displayed a burst of speed attempting to scurry past rivals into contention, but ran out of energy nearing the top of the stretch. WASCALLY RABBIT faded off a ground-saving journey.
