RIGHT ONE (FR) sat contently towards the back of the pack while racing along the outside, swung five wide into the stretch, with the rider setting chilly in the saddle, gained readily during the ensuing furlong, was given some rein and scooted by to take over, neared the sixteenth pole with a clear advantage, then edged away under light hand urging. BEAU CHOIX took the inside route, bided time until the head of the stretch, was commencing to rally when NICANOR took over the rail in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was taken in hand to avoid heels, altered course to the middle under steady left handed encouragement, finished with good energy to garner place honors. ZIFZAF three wide around the second turn, got out finished. NICANOR sat well placed stalking the pacesetter from the two path during the initial six furlongs, was asked for a response after entering the stretch, ducked inward, displacing his entry mate upon arriving at the three-sixteenths pole, made a bid to loom boldly with an eighth to go, but could not sustain the move. LUBASH fought the bit during the early stages, offering some resistance to the rating tactics being applied by the rider, was taken outward and drew alongside NICANOR, was pushed outward a couple of more paths by that opponent midway down the backstretch, eventually settled to be three wide to prompt the leader, acting more professionally by now, kept pace until upper stretch and steadily weakened thereafter. FLAT BOLD four wide departing the chute, moved past a pair of reluctant early front runners to grab command, was placed in the two path, showed the way being rated until the quarter pole, was let out when tested at that station, held his ground well for an additional furlong and gave way.
