FRIVOLOUS BUCK sat within range while undergoing a three to four wide journey, ranged up to the leader approaching the quarter pole, was called upon and took off after that opponent, spinning into the lane, made little progress during the initial portion of the run through the furlong grounds, gained more readily thereafter, reached even terms in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, grabbed the lead a few strides later and edged away under a vigorous hand ride. BELLAMY STAR with a snug hold being applied by the rider on the reins, nonetheless looped by the competition to grab the front, set the pace, well rated in the two path until the quarter pole, was let out a notch as the pressure began to intensify, lost little if any ground during the next eighth, felt the top one's presence nearing the sixteenth pole, yielded to that one but dug in with good determination for the place. SENADA well reserved, improved position with a four wide move around the far turn, turned from there into the lane, and displayed a good kick down the center of the course en route for the show. MINER'S TUNE rated while prompting the pacesetter three wide for nearly three-quarters, weakened during the final furlong. SOTIQUE strung out three wide around the opening bend, settled a bit more closer to the rail upon reaching the backstretch, bided time near the back of the pack, commenced to rally from the fourth path at the top of the stretch and rallied mildly to improve position. FASHION INSIDER under a firm hold tracking the front runners from the inside, faltered. DIXIE RHYTHM placed under a firm hold early, took the inside route and had no rally. ROYAL SIGHTING bobbled at the start, moved up to settle into midpack remained within range for three-quarters and folded.
