Footnotes

THAT'S RICH took control soon after leaving the starting gate, was planted in the two path, under a firm hold, and showed the way on a loosely-contested lead, turned for home holding a comfortable advantage then lengthened away, ridden out down the lane. AL'S LARK chased three wide and got up for the place. ALCANUDANCE bobbled slightly at the start, was guided over to the inside, cut the corner into the lane, was quickly angled outward and asked for run, never posed a threat to the winner at any time in the stretch while getting out finished for the place as well. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC raced along the outside, was urged on the turn and lacked the necessary stretch response. DRINK AT LAST CALL was pulled off ALCANUDANCE in time to avoid contact at the start, left the backstretch three wide, angled gradually outward for the stretch drive, settled into the six path, to be widest of all, kicked in with a mild rally to improve position. CALLMETONY underwent a four wide pursuit and folded. LEAP DAY stumbled at the start, recovered and assumed a forward position, was coaxed along while stalking the pacesetter three wide around the turn, gave way after completing a half. LING LING QI was never in the hunt.
