AMERICAN CLASSIC perched three wide off the ongoing pace fight, moved up when ready approaching the quarter pole, was asked for run and forged to the front coming to the eighth pole, then dug in under a drive to prevail. KEECHI BULLET unhurried for nearly six furlongs, swung four wide and kicked in with good energy once straightened away to rally for the place. BON MARIE placed under a good hold early, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, slipped into the two path just prior to the quarter pole, remained on a hold, stuck in traffic during the upcoming sixteenth of a mile, altered course outward for freedom and came home willingly to secure the show. GIOPI (IRE) saved ground until the quarter pole, swung towards the middle of the course after entering the stretch and finished well for the last major share. GOLDEN WEEKEND dueled inside and weakened during the final furlong. CAYO HUESO disputed the pace from the two path until the eighth pole and gave way. CAN'T REFUSE hustled early, raced between rivals on the turn and failed to reach a contending position. PAVORATTI'S SOUL four wide around the turn, tired after going a half.
