Footnotes

ANAPHYLAXIS secured a forward position in the initial stages, sat well placed in the two path behind the front runners under a firm hold until the five-sixteenth pole, was forced to bide time, caught behind rivals, maintained position, but while being lightly coaxed at this stage, continued to idle in upper stretch as an opening between rivals was being developed, was eventually given his cue and went through coming to the furlong marker to take over, edged away slightly from the competition, had the runner up draw up alongside soon afterwards but held on for the decision. FRISKY CAT broke slowly, raced from off the outside, angled out for the stretch run and came home with good late foot en route for the place. PROFESSOR CHAOS three wide entering the turn, was five wide exiting it, rallied with good energy down the outside of the course to grab show honors. SOLENKO chased three wide and weakened in the last eighth. TRAININGFORSUCCESS bobbed at the start, was sent over to the inside, got taken in hand when in a bit tight in the vicinity of the half mile pole, angled outward during the later stages of the run around the bend, made a nice run from upper to midstretch to reach prominence, but soon flattened

out. HIDDEN VOW vied for the lead from the outside until mid lane and gave way. MAD BOMBER off the inside, lacked the needed response. SNACKS raced three wide and tired. POINT TO KARAKORUM came in a bit at the start, was never in contention. NATIVE BREEZE was no threat. RIVER RON shied inward at the start, reacting to the oncoming presence of POINT TO KARAKORUM, drifted outward into the middle of the course down the backstretch and was always outrun. SAY LANCELOT argued for control from the rail for almost a half, faltered.
