Footnotes

HANNIBAL LECTER sat within range bidding time from the two path off the frontrunning pair, had ABRA began to back away slightly coming to the five-sixteenths pole creating enough space to maneuver outward into the three path, did so, continued to bid time for just a little while longer and got turned loose, ate up real estate readily during the ensuing furlong to poke a head down in front, kicked away. NEVADA KID was steadied and taken slightly more to the outside during the initial phases, after the antics coming from ABRA at that stage, left the midway point on the turn three wide, fanned outward entering the stretch until about in the six path by the three-sixteenths marker, displayed good late energy to procure the place. TANCREDI coaxed along the inside while dueling with SENSE OF PEACE, had the eventual winner crank up the pressure as the field was headed for the end of the bend, got called upon, fell back by a sliver after a tussle through the furlong grounds, weakened into the show slot. COALTOWN LEGEND sluggish after leaving the starting gate, was taken seven wide (widest of all) into upper stretch, mustered up a belated kick to grab the last major check. BUDDY JONES was bumped into soundly by an errant ABRA prior to arriving at the five-eighths pole, raced in the two path on the turn, got called upon after halfway around it, made no headway. ABRA forwardly placed after the start, swerved out suddenly initiating contact with BUDDY JONES and leading the runner up to take up evasive action to avoid being bumped himself, started the chase on the pair up ahead three wide, but after dropping back a bit coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was one path wider at that station, tired after entering the stretch. SENSE OF PEACE duelled for command from the outside unasked for run until near the quarter pole, gave way.
